Year End Membership Reporting Deadlines!!!!

We have less than 8 days to reactivate expired members by ensuring their dues payments are received at the Moose International Dues Processing Center. We must also ensure that all eligible applicants are enrolled and transmitted to Moose International prior to 10pm Central Time on April 30, 2010.

Any new or former member applications received by a Lodge, Chapter or Moose Legion must be transmitted, error free, to Moose International before 10:00pm Central Time, April 29, 2010, if the Lodge, Chapter or Moose Legion intends to report them as enrolled prior to 10pm Central Time on April 30, 2010.

10pm Central Time on Friday, April 30, 2010 is the deadline for transmitting any application to count towards a 2009-2010 Quota, or to transmit an enrollment date for any applicant to be counted as an Active member at 4/30/2010. Remember, in order to report an applicant's enrollment date on April 30, 2010, an error free application must have been transmitted to, and accepted by, Moose International prior to 10:00pm Central Time on April 29, 2010.

REVISION To Governor's Award Of Excellence - Expanded Eligibility For Lodges

After receiving additional input from our Lodge members, the requirement that a Lodge have 100 Active Members at May 1st has been changed. The program has been revised to require Lodges have at least 100 Active Members at April 30th, the close of the Governor's term. This allows Lodges with under 100 Active Members at the beginning of the year to grow their membership to over 100 members, securing eligibility for their Lodge Governor to be recognized for his efforts. The inaugural year for the Governor's Award of Excellence begins on May 1, 2010.

Sponsors, Lodges And Chapters ALL Benefit When They Climb Aboard The Moose MEMBER-SHIP

Lodge members and WOTM Co-workers who sponsor two applications during this campaign, which runs through May 31, 2010, will have their name entered in a drawing to win one of three cruises for two aboard the Carnival Splendor, which sails to the Mexican Riviera from October 10-17, 2010. For each additional application reported during the campaign period, the sponsor

will receive another entry in the drawing. All applications must be transmitted to Moose International via LCL.Net by 10:00 PM CDT on May 31, 2010 to be eligible.

The remaining cruises will be awarded on May 1 and June 1, 2010. Sponsors are eligible to receive only one of the three cruises-for-two packages. The award is for the cruise only; it does not include air transportation to Los Angeles. Cruise tickets are transferable, but they must be used for the October 10, 2010, departure.

As an added bonus, if both applicants are reported as enrolled into the Lodge or Chapter by May 31, 2010, Moose International will pay the sponsor's next year's dues. It's so simple - sponsor two applicants between March 1 & May 31, make sure they are enrolled by the end of the campaign and WAVE NEXT YEAR'S DUES GOODBYE!

Attention Lodge and Chapter Officers: Please ensure all of your members are aware that they can receive a free year's dues by sponsoring and enrolling two members during this campaign.
