Online Dues Payment Is The ONLY Method Left To Ensure Expired Members Are Reactivated Prior To April 30th

There is no longer time to mail in an expired member's dues payment and be certain that they will be moved to "active" member status prior to the April 30, 2011 fiscal year end. Members desiring to return to active status in time to be counted toward a Lodge, Chapter or Moose Legion's active member count at April 30th should go to www.mooseintl.org and Left-Click on the "Pay Dues Online" link. Successful online payments received through 11:59 PM Central Time on Saturday, April 30, 2011, will be counted as active members in determining final active member counts for 2010-2011 year.

Year End Membership Reporting Deadlines. Please Note Important Deadline Changes!!!!

Just four days remain to reactivate expired members by ensuring their dues payments are received at the Moose International Dues Processing Center. We must also ensure that all eligible applicants are enrolled and transmitted to Moose International prior to 10:00 PM Central Time on April 30, 2011. Every Lodge, Chapter and Moose Legion should be personally contacting their members in "expired" status to encourage a prompt payment of their dues and return to "active" member status.

SPECIAL SATURDAY APRIL 30, 2011 APPLICATION AND ENROLLMENT PROCESSING

Any new or former member applications received by a Lodge, Chapter or Moose Legion must be transmitted, error free, to Moose International before 1:00 PM Central Time, Saturday, April 30, 2011, if the Lodge, Chapter or Moose Legion intends to report them as enrolled prior to 10:00 PM Central Time on April 30, 2011.

Lodges, Chapters and Moose Legions will not be able to utilize LCL.Net to transmit application or enrollment information to Moose International from 1:00 PM Central Time on Saturday, April 30, 2011 through 2:00 PM Central Time on Saturday, April 30, 2011, while all pending "transmitted" applications, including those transmitted early on Saturday, April 30th, are processed and updated to "accepted" status.

Beginning at 2:00PM Central Time on Saturday, April 30, 2011, Lodges, Chapters and Moose Legions will once again be able to:

- 1) Transmit new applications that will count towards their application totals
- 2) Be able to report as "enrolled", any "accepted" applications showing in LCL.Net, including those new applications that were transmitted to Moose International on Saturday, April 30th, prior to 1:00 PM Central Time

Once Again, 10:00PM Central Time on Saturday, April 30, 2011 is the deadline for transmitting any application to count toward 2010-2011 recognition programs, or to transmit an enrollment date for any applicant to be counted as an Active Member at 4/30/2011. Remember, in order to report an applicant's enrollment date late in the day on April 30, 2011, an error free application must have been transmitted to, and accepted by, Moose International prior to 1:00pm Central Time on Saturday, April 30, 2011.

Delayed Processing For Lodge, Chapter and Moose Legion Transmissions

Beginning at 10:00 PM Central Time on Saturday, April 30, 2011, all Lodge, Chapter and Moose Legion transmissions to Moose International will be held until the year end closing processes are completed. The closing processes are expected to be complete by the morning of Tuesday, May 3, 2011.

Transmissions received during this period will be held in a suspense file and processed upon completion of the closing processes. On the morning of Tuesday, May 3, 2011, we anticipate returning to the normal processing of applications and updates to member records.

2011-2012 Officer Entry Should Not Be Attempted Until Monday, May 2, 2011.

Newly elected Officers should NOT be reported to Moose International until after May 1, 2011. The 2011-2012 Officers Are reported using the online admin screen available to Administrators, Recorders and Moose Legion Secretaries from their personal "My Moose Record" Screen.

Later this week, details will be released on the Revised Premiere Lodge Award Program for 2011-2012, and a new program for Lodges, the Certificate Of Administrative Compliance.
