Lodges, Chapters And Moose Legions To Notify Moose International Of Members Wishing To Resign. Our Information Systems Department advises that prior to the release of LCL.Net version 2.0, the "resigned" function available at the lodges, chapters and Moose Legions did not communicate the resigned status to the database at Moose International. This feature has been enabled in version 2.0, which should now be installed at all lodges, chapters and Moose Legions.

When a member contacts Moose International requesting to resign their membership, they will be referred to their lodge, chapter or Moose Legion. This will enable you to identify what led the member to this decision and provide an opportunity to clarify a potential misunderstanding or rectify some existing condition to convince them to continue their Moose membership. While you may not keep every member who wishes to resign, their comments may provide insight as to what other members are thinking as well.
