We request that all Endowment Fund donations collected be remitted to Moose Charities on a monthly basis. Any extraordinarily large sum collected at a special event should be remitted immediately. Please make checks payable to Moose Charities with "Endowment Fund" noted on the memorandum line of the check. Lodges and Moose Legions, please remit your checks to Moose Charities, 155 S. International Drive, Mooseheart, IL 60539-1100. Chapters, please include your check with the Chairman's Form 114 to Women of the Moose Headquarters.

Detailed Examinations of Lodge and Chapter Books, Records and Operations Are Back!

In December of 2007, we created a team of Operations Analysts who have been making visitations to Lodges to verify compliance with a host of regulatory, financial and reporting guidelines.

We have transitioned the duties of the Operations Analyst toward performing lengthier, more detailed examinations of a Lodge's or Chapter's operations and performance. This enabled the Operations Analyst to make specific recommendations for operational changes with a focus on maximizing member satisfaction, profitability and both fraternal and regulatory compliance. On rare occasions, these examinations also uncover financial indiscretions on the parts of officers or members which are documented and provided to local criminal authorities.
