LCL.net 2.0 And QuickBooks Pro 2007 Are NOT Windows Vista 64-bit Compatible LCL.net Version 2.0 is compatible with the Microsoft Windows Vista 32-bit operating system. However, LCL.net Version 2.0 is not compatible with the Microsoft Windows Vista 64-bit operating system. Information Systems is currently testing a new version of LCL.net with the Windows Vista 64-bit operating system. Until a solution is developed, do not purchase a new computer with the Windows Vista 64-bit operating system installed. LCL.net users should remain on the Microsoft Windows XP Professional or Windows Vista 32-bit operating systems.
