## **LEGEND OF LODGES MISSING REQUIRED INFORMATION**

Please use this LEGEND with the accompanying form to bring those lodges into compliance with several Governing Bodies of which these forms have not been filed. These are extremely important issues that each lodge must keep up-to date. In some cases, ignoring the issue may result in loss of coverage, loss of finances or possibly the loss of lodge assets.

If any lodge on this listing has check (X) marks for any reason, somebody is not doing their job. We need everyone's help in getting every lodge straightened away immediately. These issues cannot be put off for even one day.

**A - These lodges are shown to be a "NOT GOOD STANDING CORPORATIONS" with CT Corporation. This has resulted in some lodges as being dropped by the California Department of Commerce from their listing of "Valid Corporations" in the State of California. Losing the protection provided by being a Valid Corporation could result in the loss of Assets of the lodge as well as the personal assets of the officers. Questions? **B - Lodge Safety Forms were due on 4/1/10. These forms are required by your insurance carrier to project the risk involved for covering our lodges, with the coverage these carriers provide. When a lodge fails to submit these forms, the carrier then projects the lodge's risk as the highest possible. This increases the premiums for every lodge, by increasing the total risk of the fraternity. Get them submitted to Cynthia Trainor-Moose International-Insurance Department. **C – The lodges in this column (as of 5/31/10) have not reported their elected officer for 2010 to Moose International. It is a requirement of the Department of Commerce for the State of California. It must be done immediately.**

**D – Every lodge must submit a Pre-Examination Checklist to me to be forwarded to Department of Lodge Operations. This form is used as an aid to help our analysts in cutting down the time necessary to do an examination of your lodge's records during his visitation. It also will assist in helping him decide if there are any areas that he may concentrate on to improve your lodge's operation. The lodges have had this in their position for several weeks and I must have them sent to me by May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2010.**

In the best interests of our lodges, I am requesting that these matters be addressed immediately. As always, I am grateful for the assistance I receive from most of our lodges, their Administrators and officers, our District Presidents, and Members to get all of these issues tackled.
