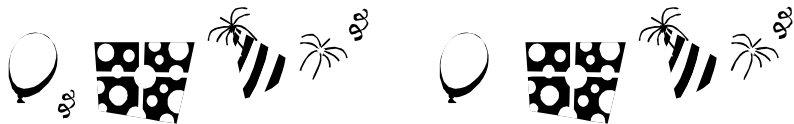

Recipe Corner:

HOMEMADE SPLIT PEA SOUP

- 1 Bag split peas
- 2 quarts water
- 1/2 Large Ham Steak Slice
- 1 1/2 cups chopped onions (small dicing)
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1 cup diced celery
- 1 cup diced carrots

Rinse peas in strainer. Place water, ham, salt & pepper in large pan. Bring to boil, cover and reduce heat. Simmer for about 2 hours, stirring occasionally. Add celery and carrots. Cook slowly uncovered. Add additional water if the broth is too thick.

COMFORT POTATO CASSEROLE

- 2 cans (10 3/4 OZ each) condensed cream of mushroom soup
- 2 cups sour cream (16 OZ)
- 2 cups (8 OZ) shredded part-skim mozzarella cheese
- 5 green onions, sliced
- 1 package (32 OZ) frozen hash brown potatoes, thawed

In a large bowl, combine the soup, sour cream, cheese and onions; stir in potatoes until coated. Transfer to a greased 2 1/2 quart baking dish. Bake, uncovered, at 350 degrees for 1 1-1/2 hours or until potatoes are tender.

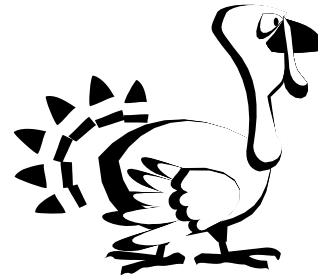

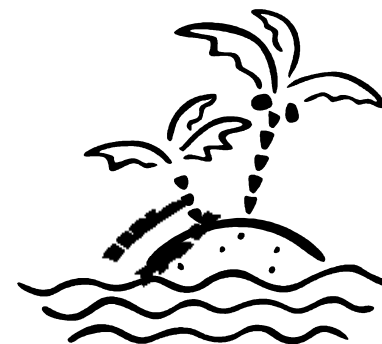
