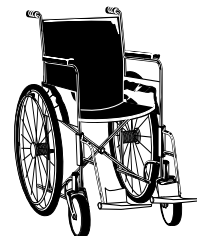

WITHOUT CHANGE, THERE CAN BE NO FUTURE

Over the weekend of January 6th through the 8th, I attended the "Making Change" Special Seminar in Las Vegas. This seminar was International in scope and comprised of members of the Supreme Lodge, Moose International, State and Provincial Association Officers, District Officers and Lodge Officers. There were over 500 in attendance.

There were four (4) major topics of discussion each session of which lasted over three hours, two on Friday and two on Saturday.

- 1) Changing our Relationship with the Community-Director General William B. Airey
The main focus of this session is letting the public know "Who we are and What we do". As you may or may not know, Reseda Lodge's last two Community Service Reports were rated "Excellent".
- 2) Changing our Approach to Membership Retention-Darrell O'Brien, Dir. Of Lodge Ops.
Our Lodge is certainly not alone in having problems maintaining members. In 1907 a Members annual dues were equivalent to one half a month's salary. This is due to the belief in "All for One and One for all". Also, during these founding moments that "Purity, Aide and Progress" were the mainstay of the Fraternity. We must instill these beliefs toward our members, be friendly on all occasions, keep our Lodge clean and safe.
- 3) Changing our Approach to Producing New Members-Shawn Baile, Dir. Of Membership
All of the current programs were reviewed and analyzed as if it were under a microscope. Reseda Lodge is having a very good year attracting New Members. There was also a lively discussion for brining in younger Members. A point was very well made when it was asked for all Members in attendance under 40 to raise their hands...3.
- 4) Changing our General Laws to Fit the Needs of our Lodges in 2012 and Beyond-General Governor Steve Greene & Director General William B. Airey
There were many, many proposed changes developed at this session. An array of antiquated procedures were discussed. There was so much activity in this area that we were requested to write down our concerns and they promised to read each one when they arrive back at Mooseheart.

By far, this was the most progressive, informative, and worthwhile event that I have ever attended as a Moose. As we receive more information on these subjects, we will keep you advised. Look at the next Moose Magazine for even more information. Until then, remember: **Purity at Home, Giving Aid When and Where Needed, and Making Progress in our Land.**

Placing a Face With a Name by Mitch "5-17" Lane



Some people develop a work ethic by the time they're in their mid to late teens. John "Bud" Cardos began developing his at age 4 when he began acting in Hollywood productions. A year later, he was signed to perform in "Our Gang Comedies."

Bud enjoyed a diverse career in Hollywood. In addition to acting, he worked 30-years as a stunt man. Working with horses was his passion. The constant work gave Bud the opportunity to travel all over the country. On five different productions, he was sent to Africa.

In later years, Bud transitioned to working "behind" the camera. He directed twelve feature films including 1977's Kingdom of the Spiders which starred William Shatner. A highlight of Bud's career is being voted into the Cowboy Hall of Fame in 1991 for directing the movie, **Legends of the West.**

Bud is a proud member of both the Moose and the Elk's. When working on locations throughout the US, Bud always sought out the local lodges. He's visited so many that he lost count! When asked what he likes most about fraternal brotherhood, he's quick to respond, "I enjoy meeting people and helping children." It goes to reason that his answer to the question, what advice do you have for fellow Moose, he says, "Seek friendship and support the many activities and programs that result in helping children."

Growing up, everyone has a relative they're particularly fond of. For Irene Barbeau, this person was her grandmother. Irene recalls her grandmother's extraordinary ability to cook and bake. "She taught me to be adventurous in the kitchen," says Irene. The only time Irene "toes the line" is when she's baking. She said, "Baking requires exact measurement." This explains why Irene's culinary offerings are soooooo delicious!



Born and raised in the San Fernando Valley, Irene attended Francis Polytechnic High School in Sun Valley. Hers was the first class to graduate from the school that was built in 1957.

Irene and her husband were members of the VFW. In 1999, a VFW friend named Betty Knoch asked Irene if she wanted to accompany her for Tacos at the Moose Lodge. Irene was quite impressed. After a couple more visits, Betty told Irene, "After three visits, they'd like you to consider joining the Lodge." She and her husband jumped at the opportunity.


