2 Day Hands on Technical Training sessions, otherwise known as a 2 HOTT, will be conducted in northern CA and southern CA during the months of May through October. We have also scheduled one session in June (the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>) in southern NV. It is a mandatory requirement that a Recorder working toward the Star Recorder degree **must** attend a 2 HOTT during her term of office. It is also a mandatory requirement that any current Recorder (Star Recorder or holding a call card for the degree) who wishes to submit her name to the nominating committee for the office of Recorder for a second year and each succeeding year thereafter must have attended a 2 HOTT within the last 2 years to be eligible for nomination. For an existing Recorder this requirement began with the 2009 – 2010 fraternal unit year, which is May 2009 through April 2010, so those individuals who attended a 2 HOTT during this period will not be required to attend a 2 HOTT until the 2011 fraternal unit year (May 2011 through April 2012). If she did not meet this requirement and has been elected she **must** attend an upcoming session during the 2010 – 2011 fraternal unit year. It is the individual's responsibility to ensure that they attend a 2 HOTT in accordance with these published Women of the Moose General Laws. Your training team would like to reiterate that sessions are scheduled to ensure that the majority of areas within our states are covered with a three hour maximum travel distance, however we must remember that CA/NV is a large area of coverage and in some instances it is just not possible to schedule a session within those limits. With this in mind it is very important that those individuals who **must** attend a session make it a priority to attend when it is scheduled nearest them. Sessions will not be scheduled in the same location twice during the fraternal unit year. We would also like to clarify that there is no such thing as a makeup 2 HOTT and that there is a minimum requirement of 10 attendees to conduct a 2 HOTT session.
