- * New Special Committee Chairman - Moose Charities Chairman - sole purpose is to raise additional funds for Moose Charities for Mooseheart and Moosehaven - such as additional donations to the Endowment Fund, Gimme 5, Mooseheart or Moosehaven Operations, Capital Projects.

Chairman can select her committee members. Please, co-workers, we must continue to maintain and support our Twin Cities and this will also benefit the chapter.

As with all other Special Committee Chairmen, this is not a mandatory appointment but one that is essential to the continued support and maintenance of Mooseheart and Moosehaven.

- * New Inserts for Chapter Procedures and Agendas now available for purchase in Catalog Sales. Three copies of the inserts only (no binders) will be shipped to each chapter and billed at a cost of \$5.00 each plus shipping and handling.

- * Continue with pin for sponsoring one new member remains....

- * Discontinuing the Charm for sponsoring two new members. Will now have a lovely pendant and chain for sponsoring five new members.

* Academy of Friendship Gold-Filled Ring will still be available for purchase as in past years.
OR - We will also have available for purchase a Gold Filled Ring attached to a gold-tone bow.
This will enable it to be worn at any time.

Women of the Moose General Laws - July 1, 2007 amended as follows:

Section 38, d. to read:

Any co-worker who intentionally surrenders her membership card for the purpose of terminating her membership shall be suspended from membership for a period of one hundred eighty (180) days from date of suspension, unless a dispensation to retain her membership is granted by the Grand Chancellor. If she wishes to be readmitted into the chapter, she shall write a letter to the Board of Officers requesting readmission and shall be balloted on by the chapter the same as a new member. The majority vote rules. If the co-worker does not request to be readmitted, she shall be dropped from membership at the end of the one hundred eighty (180) days suspension.

Section 48, i to read:

For her services, the Recorder may receive reasonable compensation as determined by the chapter Board of Officers and membership. Compensation shall be paid or waived, but may not be accrued. Compensation listed in a report to Women of the Moose Headquarters and not paid to the Recorder for that reporting period shall automatically be waived or forfeited upon the filing of the next required report.

Section 48, j to read:

All compensation paid to a Recorder is subject to local government regulations. In the event a Recorder elects to waive her compensation, it must be waived for the entire year. The compensation waived by the Recorder shall remain in the chapter's General Fund. If a vacancy should occur in the office of Recorder, the co-worker performing the duties and responsibilities of that office may receive the compensation allocated to the Recorder for the period of her actual service.

Section 65,e to read:

The Committee Activity Nights of Academy of Friendship, College of Regents, Star Recorder and Green Cap/Ways and Means shall be open to members of the Loyal Order of Moose, qualified guests and prospective members.

Section 64, g - addition:

Meetings shall be held as scheduled and are open to all good standing members and minor children in their care, when and if it is necessary.

Section 71, b is eliminated.
