## CALIFORNIA NEVADA MOOSE ASSOCIATION (CNMA) 2026 MID-YEAR CONFERENCE

Enclosed is information concerning our upcoming 2026 Mid-Year Conference scheduled for March 20 to 22 at the Hilton Orange County/Costa Mesa, 3050 Bristol St, Costa Mesa CA 92626. **The cutoff date for reserving a room is February 25th.** The telephone number for reservations is (800) 445-8667 using **Group Code: 90E**. You can also reserve your room online at our dedicated Moose booking page at: [HOTEL REGISTRATION](#). Be sure to check the **DATES** under “Your Stay” at the top of the page and **edit them for your planned date of arrival and departure**.

Room Rates are as follows: \$190 per night which includes all applicable taxes, fees, and on-site parking. This is a **complete** rate for a Standard King or a Standard Double Queen room. Please make your room reservations as soon as possible before the **cutoff date of February 25, 2026**. After that date all unsold rooms will be released to the public and sold at the hotel's higher rate. Again, be sure to use our **Group Code 90E** to receive the reduced rate. On site parking for those only attending the event is \$5 per day.

If you are in need of a scooter for the conference we have posted information to the CNMA website > Conventions > [Scooter Rentals](#). The Medical Store in Costa Mesa has always been a valuable resource for obtaining a scooter including delivery and pick up of the scooter to the Hilton Orange County/Costa Mesa. We are attaching it to this mailing package for your convenience.

As always we encourage everyone to **pre-register online and purchase your meals in advance**. **No meal purchases will be available on site**. Attendance and advanced meal purchases help to keep our costs down. We can only keep our prices lower by meeting our room blocks and meal requirements.

Just a couple of friendly reminders:


1. District Presidents will only be reimbursed for hotel expenses at the Hilton Orange County/Costa Mesa.
